Welcome

Today we want you to learn about the value of true worship. This is an awesome opportunity for you to sense God's presence and touch Him with your worship. Some people may think that worshipping God means to sing songs or to pray. Praying and singing songs to God are good things to do. But worship means more than singing songs and praying. Worship means adoring God by living truthful lives before Him. Worship should be a lifestyle, not an event.



Main Lesson

The Woman At The Well: John 4

One day when Jesus was on his way back to Galilee, He had to pass through a town in Samaria. He was walking because in those days they did not have cars, buses or planes. It had been very hot and He was thirsty. As He came into the town, He saw a well, which is a place where you could get water.

In those days they did not have taps for water. He walked over to the well and sat down. A Samaritan woman came to draw water from the well. Jesus asked her for some water. The Samaritan woman was shocked and asked how He, a Jew, could ask her, a Samaritan, for a drink. She told Jesus that He didn't even have a bucket to draw water from the well. Jesus told her that He could give her living water. She asked Him how He was going to do that. Jesus explained that everyone who drinks water from the well will get thirsty again, but anyone who asked Him for living water would never thirst again. The woman then asked Jesus for this water. She went on and asked Him about where she should worship. Jesus told her that it didn't matter where you worship, what mattered was who you are and the way you live your life before God. God is looking for those who will worship Him in spirit and in truth. Jesus went on and told her that He was the Messiah. After they had finished talking she left Jesus and ran into the town and told everyone about Jesus.

This woman recognised who Jesus was and worshipped Him. I want to ask you, what does it mean to worship in truth? It means that you come to Jesus just as you are. You should not try to be like your friend. You need to be who God created you to be and worship Him by being the best person you can be. Let's say our Key Point: **Worship God every day.**

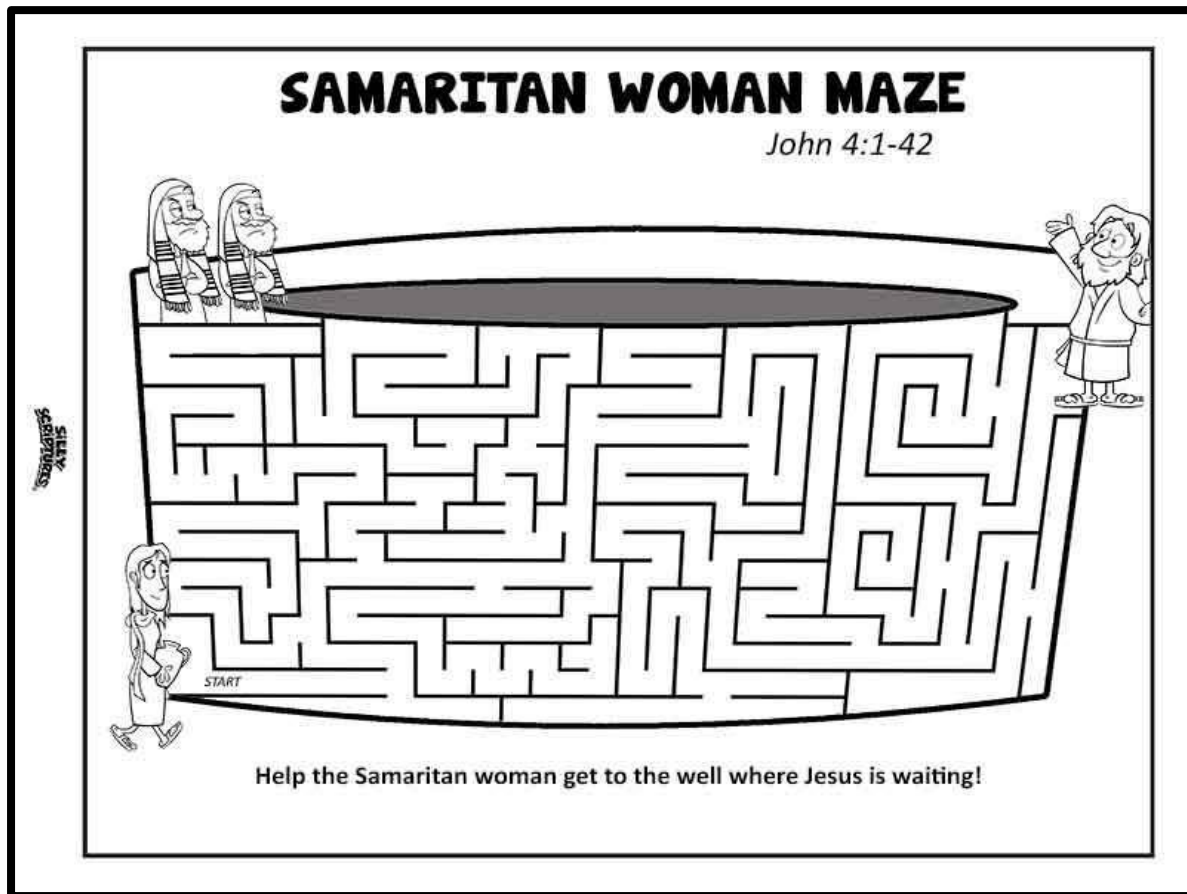
